It has been a very long winter; however, spring is in the air. We are excited in preparation for many of the festivities the City of Durand hosts every year, such as Railroad Days and End of Summer Cruise. It is important to be aware of a few of our local Ordinances:

City Code 82-32: It is the duty of the occupant or the owner of every premise within the City to cut or mow any grass and to cut, mow, remove or destroy by lawful means any such weeds whenever such grass/weeds have grown to a length of six inches.

* Contact will be attempted by the Ordinance Violation Officer in the event of grass and/or weeds. The address in violation will then be turned over to the appropriate company to be mowed.

If the occupant or owner of the property fails to comply with the City Code, after being notified of the violation, a citation may be issued and/or the City may have the grass/weeds cut at the property owner's expense.

City Code 34-72: No partially dismantled, inoperable, or wrecked motor vehicle(s) shall be stored out of doors within the City for a period of time in excess of seven days unless within an approved storage area. A vehicle is not considered a junk vehicle if it has an engine that runs, has four wheels and four pneumatic tires capable of holding air and a working battery.

City Code 10(6-7) Pets at City Events: No person shall allow a domestic animal owned by them or under their control (leashed or not) upon public streets, sidewalks and other public property in the following areas of the City during Railroad Days and End of Summer Cruise:

City Code 10-8 (1 & 2) Pets at City Events: No person shall allow a domestic animal owned by them or under their control (leashed or not) upon public property in the following areas of the City During Farmer's Market and Wednesday Night Live:

*A person who requires a service dog is exempt from the above City Code. A person, who violates this Code, may be issued a citation.

City Code 50-184 (b) Bicycles, Roller Blades, Skate Boards, etc.: It is a violation of this Code to ride a bicycle, roller blades, roller skates, skate board, coaster or similar device on a public sidewalk, parking lot and or street within the following areas of the City:
