HMA PAVEMENT REPAIR SCOPE OF WORK

Hot Mix Asphalt repairs in various areas in the City of Durand will consist of the following:

Various areas of full depth repairs ranging from 100 square feet to 500 square feet. All are mostly filled with crushed limestone. (Limestone must be returned to the City)

Saw Cut Asphalt:

Full depth repairs are to be saw cut or milled through the full thickness of the existing asphalt. This item will include saw cutting/milling existing asphalt up to a thickness of 6-inches. Saw cuts are to be made perpendicular to the asphalt surface. Average pavement thickness is 4-5-inches. Some locations will require additional asphalt thickness to match existing.

Remove existing asphalt and/or crushed limestone fill:

Existing asphalt and/or crushed limestone and/or cold patch is to be removed from repair area to the existing asphalt depth. This will include removing and disposing of asphalt/removing crushed limestone and returning it to the City. Care must be taken to not damage outer edge of repair area. Disposal site will be made available on request.

Place Hot Mix Asphalt:

This item will include compacting existing base material and preparing area for placing Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA). HMA is to be placed in two lifts of approximately equal thickness. Each is to be compacted in place immediately after being placed. Asphalt tack compound shall be applied to repair area prior to placing second lift. HMA and tack compound shall be furnished, transported, handled and placed according to Michigan Department of Transportation Standards for HMA Full Thickness Pavement Patching. Process batch tickets must be supplied for this item.
